COURSE DESCRIPTION

As a peer supporter, it is common for you to think, "I don't know how to help, manage, or assess this situation." This one-day training is designed to eliminate the concern of providing support when the issue is uncomfortable. We will critically examine scenarios in which peer support members might find themselves. A brief lecture will be given to introduce the topic and the remainder of the class will be devoted to tabletop and class discussions. Make sure you are prepared to assess, discuss, share your experiences, and learn from others.
