Leadership doesn't start with rank. Every officer leads – whether they wear stripes or not.

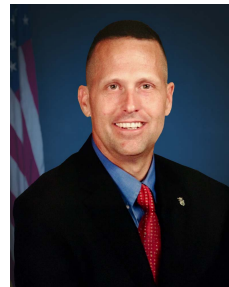
